The Checklist I

- 1 Stable / Works Every Time
 - Idempotent
 - Match source 100%
- 2 Automatic
 - Remove human error
 - Ensure regularly done
- 3 Different Storage Media
 - Separate from source
 - Avoid physical failure

The Checklist II

- 4 Fast
 - Too long will not be run
 - Short commitment
- 5 Efficient
 - Compression
 - 3 months worth
- 6 Secure
 - Untrusted networks
 - Encryption needed

The Checklist III

- 7 Versioned
 - Corruption of data happens
 - Restore point in time
- 8 Offsite / Remote
 - Natural disasters
 - Redundancy
- 9 Restore Tested
 - Trust but verify
 - Hope is not a plan!

Duplicity vs. The Checklist I

- 1 Stable / Works Every Time
 - Uses rdiff so filesystem independent
- 2 Automatic
 - Able to be run via cron
 - Some GUI scheduling
- 3 Different Storage Media
 - Can use external drives
 - Remote storage locations

Duplicity vs. The Checklist II

- 4 Fast
 - Full backups can take awhile
 - Incrementals only get changes
- 5 Efficient
 - Stored in GNU tar format
 - Small diff tar files (25MB default)
- 6 Secure
 - Use GnuPG to encrypt files
 - SSH & HTTPS protocols supported

Duplicity vs. The Checklist III

- 7 Versioned
 - Full and Incremental
 - Time-based Restores
- 8 Offsite / Remote
 - S3, WebDAV, SCP/SFTP
 - External USB HDD
- 9 Restore Tested
 - Hash signature verification
 - Verify command

Packages To Install I

Debian/Ubuntu Systems

`aptitude install duplicity`

- Wheezy: 0.6.18
- Jessie: 0.6.23
- 12.04 LTS: 0.6.18
- 13.10: 0.6.21

Caveat

`python-paramiko < 1.12` does not support ECDSA host keys

Use `ssh -o 'HostKeyAlgorithms=ssh-rsa,ssh-dss'`

Packages To Install II

CentOS

```
yum install duplicity
```

- CentOS 5: 0.6.21
- CentOS 6: 0.6.22

Caveat

Requires the EPEL repository be configured

Performing Backups I

Automatically determines if a Full or Incremental backup should be performed

Automatic Backup Level

```
duplicity /home file:///media/externalHDD
```

Can explicitly perform a given backup level

Explicit Backup Level

```
duplicity full /home file:///media/externalHDD
```

```
duplicity incr /home file:///media/externalHDD
```

Verify Backup

```
duplicity verify file:///media/externalHDD /home
```

Performing Backups II

Can list all backup sets available

Check Backups Available

```
duplicity collection-status file://media/exampleHDD
```

Can list files that are currently backed up in the archive from the signature manifest.

Check Backups Available

```
duplicity list-current-files file://media/exampleHDD
```

Restore From Backup

Perform a full restore

Restore Backup Set

```
duplicity file://media/externalHDD /home
```

Restore Options

```
duplicity -t 3D file://media/externalHDD /home/restore  
duplicity --file-to-restore path/file file://media/externalHDD  
/home/restore_file
```

Duplicity Options I

Many options available. `man duplicity`

- `-exclude-device-files`
- `-exclude-filelist=filename`
- `-include-globbing-filelist=filename`
- `-encrypt-key=gpg-key-id`
- `-sign-key=gpg-key-id`
- `-archive-dir=path`
- `-time=time`

Duplicity Options II

Optional environment variables helpful when scripting

- FTP_PASSWORD - Used for FTP login
- PASSPHRASE - Passed to GnuPG
- SIGN_PASSPHRASE - Passed to GnuPG

Packages To Install

Debian/Ubuntu Systems

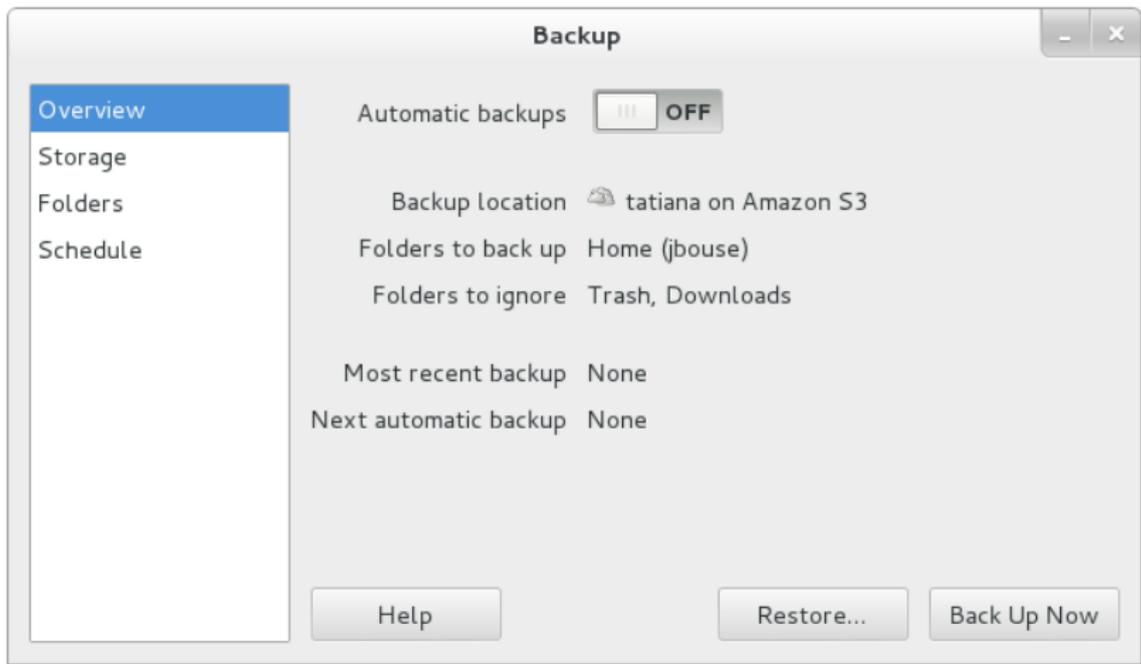
```
aptitude install deja-dup
```

- Wheezy: 20.2
- 12.04 LTS: 22.0
- 13.10: 27.3.1

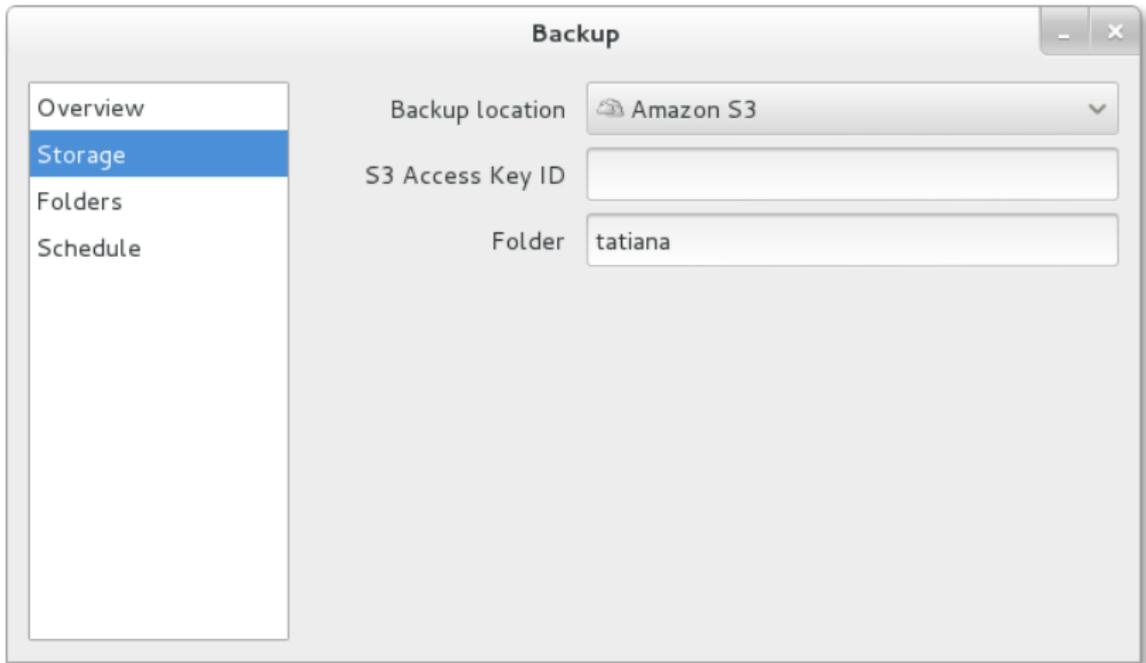
Caveat

Currently no package in Debian Jessie

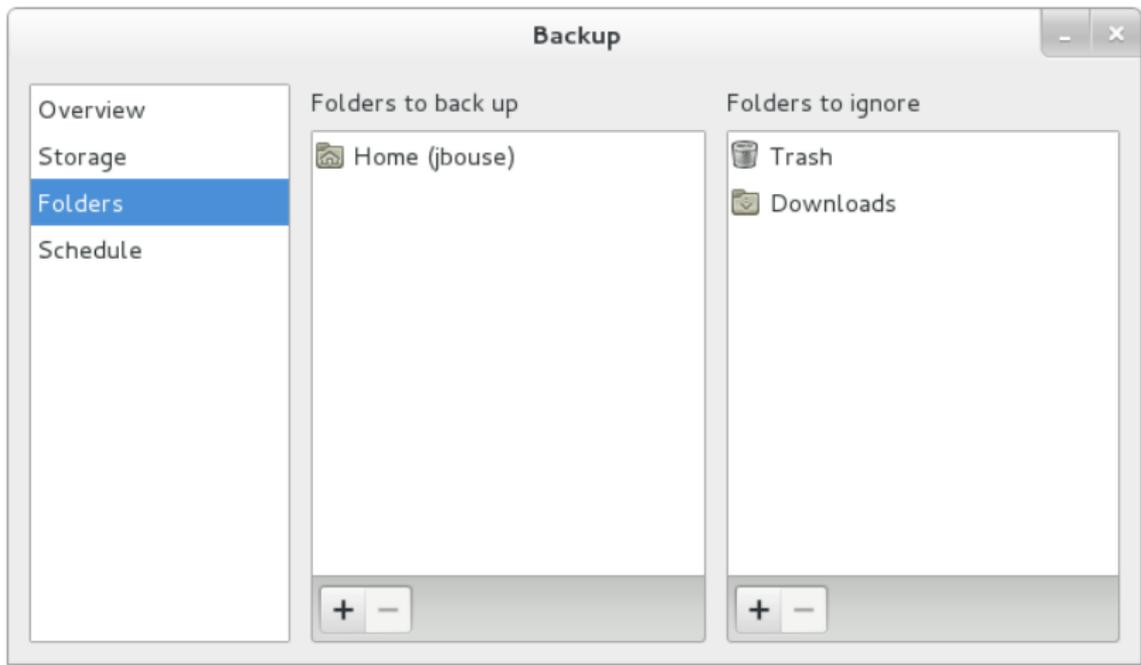
